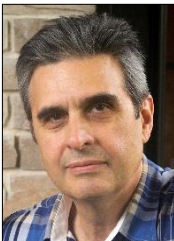

She holds a Ph.D. from Université de Montréal and an M.A. from McGill University. She is the recipient of the 2018 Premio Italia nel Mondo (Italy in the World Prize) for her work in culture. She lives in Montreal.
